Introduction

Transformus 2015, the twelfth event since our founding in 2004, was held on the third weekend of July two-thousand fifteen, with participants from all around the United States and the world gathering to form the city of Mysteria, once again transforming Deerfields into the place we call "home." Community participation rose to record levels with 26 Creativity Grants, 133 registered Theme Camps and 2493 tickets sold to participants.

ORGANIZATION

Transformus, LLC, is a volunteer-run North Carolina Limited Liability Corporation (LLC) managed by a seven-person board of directors in 2015. The 2015 Board of Directors consisted of Treat (President), Moon (Vice President), firefly (Treasurer), JoeJoe (Secretary), Andi, Conway, and Kurtal Icious. Midnightt served in a BOD advisory capacity, and Catbird, Carter, and Cherm were our BOD Liaisons.

Ensuring the leadership of Transformus remains open to new members is important for keeping a balanced perspective and the long-term sustainability of our collective. We have established the role of "board liaison" which gives a training and internship period of a minimum of one year for potential board members, allowing time to see how they work within the group as well as explore their management and organizational skills both before and during the burn.

Every year in the fall the board conducts a retreat where we reflect on that year's event and look to the future. In 2015, Midnightt and Moon both officially stepped off of the BOD. They both leave an impressive legacy of contributions to what our event and our community have developed into, and both will be missed. But they won't be going anywhere! Both of them will be continuing to work with the community in new and exciting ways!

Following the retreat two dedicated and talented community members accepted our invitation to join the leadership team as Liaisons for 2016: Collette and Jessamyn. We're so grateful that these folks are willing to step up and help organize and run the event that's at the center of our year-round community.

The board and liaisons provide vision, direction, management and support to the thirty volunteer teams who build and run the city of Mysteria and who serve the Transformus community year-round. The Team Leads handle their tasks with a good deal of autonomy, while one board member serves as their point of contact and guidance. These volunteer leaders collectively create Mysteria each year. As a community, we owe them a great deal of thanks and praise.

The volunteer leadership of Transformus has remained unpaid, however, the above financial summary includes several expenses paid to several vendors who are paid in order to host a more responsible event and ease the burden on volunteers. In 2015, our paid vendors were: rental companies for radios, lights, and transportation; the landowners; an accountant; event security; legal services; first aid services; and fees to our new ticket vendor.

Donations went out to the Mills River, Rocky Point and Pleasant Garden Fire Departments and Burners Without Borders.

In addition, the "profits" from ice sales (a total of \$2,540) were donated to the school system of Henderson County with some earmarked for the Mills River Elementary School on behalf of the entire Transformus community.

CREATIVITY

Sharing creative projects that are interactive and engage others is a great way to participate in our society. The city of Mysteria is a living work of art in itself that is weaved together by each participant's gifts. The leadership group works hard to provide a fertile environment where each participant feels comfortable sharing their personal expressions of creativity.

In order to support large projects and return a portion of ticket money back to participants, \$25,041 in funds were granted to artists to enhance creativity at Transformus, bringing our historical total of grants given to \$113,061 since 2006. The Art Team curates and awards grants after a blind jury review. These grants include a wide variety of creations.

Ticket Sales

We continued our relationship with Brown Paper Tickets this year, and tickets sales went as smooth as ever. Purchases were limited to two tickets per person and cost \$108 per ticket plus fees and taxes. We continue to have extraordinary demand for tickets in all rounds. Tickets sold out in a matter of minutes. Out of 2495 tickets sold to the event, 2455 were used.

Transformus continues to require all participants to purchase their tickets; there are no complimentary tickets to anyone. We do set aside directed tickets for the BoD, team leads and coleads, creativity grant recipients, and for the landowners of Deerfields and SpiritHaven. This year the total number of directed tickets was 166.

Volunteer Statistics

Without volunteers Transformus *would not happen*. Transformus is, by design, intent and necessity, a burn with well-developed infrastructure. We not only need volunteers, we need *lots* of volunteers to make our city function.

In 2015, out of 2101 shifts listed for the event, 1867 of those were filled pre-event resulting in a 89% rate of pre-event volunteerism – consistent with 2014's breadth of coverage, despite an almost 10% increase in numbers of shifts year over year.

When the online sign-up was shut down pre-event, 39% of our community had signed up for shifts. Leadership accounted for another 7% of our population's contribution.

Transformus sets the pace in the world-wide community of Burns for volunteerism, thanks to our close- knit community of people who care about our city and the people who make it their temporary home.

THEME CAMPS

One hundred thirty-two registered Theme Camps formed the city of Mysteria in 2015. Built from the ground up and leaving no trace, these volunteer-run camps created the diverse neighborhoods of our art-city. Year after year, we appreciate what these groups help blossom with their effort, creativity, ingenuity and spice. Many thanks to these amazing collectives for your spirited commitment and participation, as truly, you are Transformus.

LANDOWNER PARTNERSHIP

Transformus has a close partnership with the landowners of Deerfields (Horse Shoe, NC), our site for the history of the event. Working with the Deerfields staff our Team Leads executed several new approaches to traffic control that made entry and exodus easier on everyone. The land was in great shape for this year's event. We thank the owners and staff of Deerfields for their part in creating our home.

FATALITY

Transformus suffered its first ever fatality during the 2015 event, when Jay Marx drowned in the lower lake. This tragic event prompted an internal review of our safety and emergency protocols, which were found to be sound. We continue to mourn Jay's loss and again offer our eternal thanks to all of the participants, volunteers, and paid EMS and Security staff who were involved in the rescue efforts and subsequent aftermath. IGNITE!

Ignite!, which began as the Transformus Town Hall, has grown into a full-fledged all-ages burn.

In 2015, thanks to the efforts of our Land Search Committee, we found a new site in Southern Virginia. Spirit Haven Farm (Stuart, VA) played host to Ignite! this year over Memorial Day weekend. Ignite! continued to have a cap of 500 adult tickets, with unlimited tickets for burners under the age of 13. Ignite! sold out for the second year in a row.

Ignite! continues to lead the way in terms of incorporating learning opportunities and leadership development through Playforms and as an all-ages inclusive burn. This year's Temple was designed by the children of Ignite!, and the Temple Burn started off with a kids' conclave.

The 2015 Ignite! Planning Committee (IPA) was made up of Lizifer vonFunshine, Shawman Warpcore, VH-One, Todd, Abi, Don, and Kelly.

THE FUTURE

Treat has been re-elected as our Board President for the 2016 season with firefly supporting him as Vice President. firefly and JoeJoe will retain their roles as Treasurer and Secretary. Andi, Conway and Kurtal Icious will continue in their roles as Board Members, and former liaison Carter has joined the BoD as a full member. This year's liaisons comprise returning liaison Catbird and new liaisons Collette and Jessamyn.

The 2016 IPA is made up of Lizifer vonFunshine, VH-One, Shawman, Don, Abi, Todd, and ChickaDawn.

The BoD has announced that we will be undertaking a third burn: Synthesis. The Synthesis Planning Force (SPF-7) is made up of vespa, WinterSun, Ranger Nugget, Kricket, Jordan La Liaison, Moon, and DTR. We look forward to the opportunity to continue to grow the burn community throughout the Southeast.

The BoD is eternally grateful to every member of this community for everything that you give to us. This community would not exist without each and every one of you.
